

# RECIPES FOR HOMEMADE DIETS — FELINE

Veterinarian or staff, check appropriate box.

## Feline Restricted Protein Diet

1/4 lb. liver (beef, chicken or pork only)  
2 large eggs, hard-cooked  
2 cups cooked white rice without salt  
1 tablespoon vegetable oil  
1 t (5 g) calcium carbonate<sup>1</sup>  
1/8 teaspoon KCl (salt substitute)

Also add a balanced supplement which fulfills the feline MDR for all vitamins and trace minerals, and 250 mg. taurine/day. Dice and braise the meat, retaining fat. Combine all ingredients and mix well. This mixture is somewhat dry and the palatability may be improved by adding some water (not milk). Yield: 1 1/4 lb.

| Carbohydrate .....          | 15.8%         |
| Moisture .....              | 70.0%         |

\*This diet supplies 21% protein calories, 35% fat calories and 44% carbohydrate calories.

Feed sufficient amount to maintain normal body weight.

| Body Weight  | Approximate Daily Feeding |
|--------------|---------------------------|
| 5 lb. ....   | 1/4 lb.                   |
| 7-8 lb. .... | 1/2 lb.                   |
| 10 lb. ....  | 3/4 lb.                   |

## Feline Reducing Diet

1/4 lb. liver (beef, chicken or pork only), cooked and ground  
1 cup cooked white rice  
1 teaspoon vegetable oil  
1 t (5 g) calcium carbonate<sup>1</sup>  
1/8 teaspoon KCl (salt substitute)

Also add a balanced supplement which fulfills the feline MDR for all vitamins and trace minerals, and 250 mg. taurine/day. Combine all ingredients. Yield: 1 1/4 lb.

| Protein .....              | 15.5%         |
| Fat .....                  | 3.4%          |
| Carbohydrate .....         | 9.2%          |
| Moisture .....             | 70.0%         |
| Metabolizable Energy ..... | 585 Kcal./lb. |

### Feeding Guide

| Optimal Body Weight | Approximate Daily Feeding |
|---------------------|---------------------------|
| 5 lb. ....          | 1/4 lb.                   |
| 7-8 lb. ....        | 1/2 lb.                   |
| 10 lb. ....         | 3/4 lb.                   |

After the cat attains optimum weight, a good quality maintenance diet at a level that just maintains that optimum weight can be initiated. Snacking and scavenging should be absolutely forbidden during the reducing period.

## Feline Hypoallergenic Diet

1/4 lb. diced lamb  
1 cup cooked white rice  
1 teaspoon vegetable oil  
1 1/2 t (7 g) dicalcium phosphate<sup>2</sup>  
1/8 teaspoon KCl (salt substitute)

Also add a balanced supplement which fulfills the feline MDR for all vitamins and trace minerals, and 250 mg. taurine/day.

Trim fat from lamb. Cook thoroughly (braise or roast) without seasoning. Add remaining ingredients and mix well. Keep covered in refrigerator. Yield: 2/3 lb.

|----------------------------|---------------|
| Protein .....              | 7.0%          |
| Fat .....                  | 10.0%         |
| Carbohydrate .....         | 14.0%         |
| Moisture .....             | 66.0%         |
| Metabolizable Energy ..... | 795 Kcal./lb. |

### Feeding Guide

Feed sufficient amount to maintain normal body weight.

| Body Weight  | Approximate Daily Feeding |
|--------------|---------------------------|
| 5 lb. ....   | 1/4 lb.                   |
| 7-8 lb. .... | 1/2 lb.                   |
| 10 lb. ....  | 3/4 lb.                   |

If the allergy is suspected to be food induced, maintain the patient on this diet and distilled water. Then expose the patient to foods, one at a time, beginning with tap water, to discover offending materials. The aim of this provocative exposure is to determine foods the patient CAN eat rather than those the patient cannot eat.

A hypoallergenic Prescription Diet® food, Canine d/d® is available in canned form. Check with your veterinarian.

## Feline Restricted Mineral and Sodium Diet

1 lb. regular ground beef, cooked  
1/4 lb. liver (beef, chicken or pork only), cooked  
1 cup cooked white rice without salt  
1 teaspoon vegetable oil  
1 t (5 g) calcium carbonate<sup>1</sup>  
1/8 teaspoon KCl (salt substitute)

Also add a balanced supplement which fulfills the feline MDR for all vitamins and trace minerals, and 250 mg. taurine/day. Combine all ingredients. Yield: 1 1/4 lb.

| Analysis                   | As Fed        |
|----------------------------|---------------|
| Protein .....              | 14.3%         |
| Fat .....                  | 13.9%         |
| Carbohydrate .....         | 6.3%          |
| Moisture .....             | 64.0%         |
| Metabolizable Energy ..... | 940 Kcal./lb. |

### Feeding Guide

Feed sufficient amount to maintain normal body weight.

| Body Weight  | Approximate Daily Feeding |
|--------------|---------------------------|
| 5 lb. ....   | 1/4 lb.                   |
| 7-8 lb. .... | 1/2 lb.                   |
| 10 lb. ....  | 3/4 lb.                   |

Two mineral restricted Prescription Diet® foods are available. For prevention of Feline Urologic Syndrome (F.U.S.), Feline c/d® is available in canned and convenient dry ten and four pound bags. For sodium restriction, Feline h/d® is available in canned form. Check with your veterinarian.

## Feline Liquid Diet

8 oz. Prescription Diet® Feline p/d® canned  
3/4 cup water.  
Blend to smooth consistency in a blender. Strain through kitchen strainer (1 mm mesh). Yield: 13 oz.

|-----------------------------|--------------|
| Protein .....               | 7.4%         |
| Fat .....                   | 5.0%         |
| Carbohydrate .....          | 2.8%         |
| Moisture .....              | 83.0%        |
| *Metabolizable Energy ..... | 24 Kcal./oz. |

\*This diet supplies 33% protein calories, 55% fat calories, and 12% carbohydrate calories.

Daily dose—1 oz./lb. body weight.
